### PUBLIC WORKS:

- CHLORINATING and FLUSHING HYDRANTS:
- The City will begin chlorinating the water supply on April 24th and will then begin to flush hydrants the week of April 29th. You may notice a smell of chlorine in your water supply, please run your faucet for a couple of minutes and the smell will disperse. You may also notice a variation of your water pressure, keep in mind that this is short term.
- **Please do not flush “flushable wipes” down the drain. They may or may not plug up your home plumbing system, but they will definitely plug the City’s sewer system. THANKS!**
