A MESSAGE FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

SNOWPLOWING: It's that time of year again. Please remove any cars, trash cans, basketball hoops and other sports equipment off the streets. We will be plowing the streets about the time the snow ends, that could be 2am or 2pm. Whatever mother Nature dictates. We typically do not come back once a street is plowed edge to edge. If you leave your car in the street and we have to plow around it, you are responsible to clean the street that did not get plowed. Please help us to do our jobs by moving your vehicles off the road and alleys when it snows.

FLUSHING HYDRANTS AND CHLORINATING THE WATER LINES: Chlorination of the water lines will start October 16th - 28th with Hydrant Flushing starting October 21st - 25th.
