Homeowners are responsible for lateral sewer line from house to main line in street.

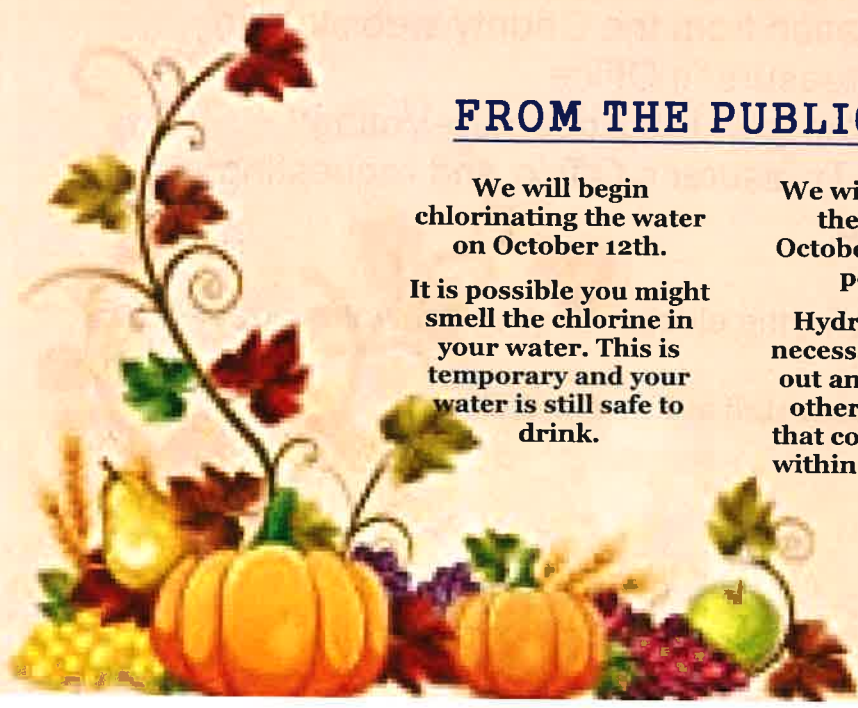
FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

We will begin chlorinating the water on October 12th.

It is possible you might smell the chlorine in your water. This is temporary and your water is still safe to drink.

We will start flushing the hydrants on October 17th (weather permitting).

Hydrant flushing is necessary to help clear out any sediment and other contaminants that could have settled within the water lines.





2022 GENERAL ELECTION ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee voting for the November 8, 2022 General Election begins September 23, 2022 and runs through November 7, 2022.

Chisago County residents can absentee vote in-person at the Chisago County Government Center, 313 North Main Street, Center City, MN 55012 during regular business hours Monday through Friday beginning September 23 and running through November 4. The Government Center will be open for absentee voting Saturday, November 5, 2022 from 10 a.m.-3 p.m. and Monday, November 7 from 8:00 a.m.-5 p.m.

You can also absentee vote by mail. To request a ballot be mailed to you, an application is required. You can apply for your ballot:

- By completing an online Absentee Ballot Application at www.mnvotes.org and clicking “Other Ways to Vote”
- By printing a paper application from the County website and returning it to the Auditor-Treasurer’s Office
