

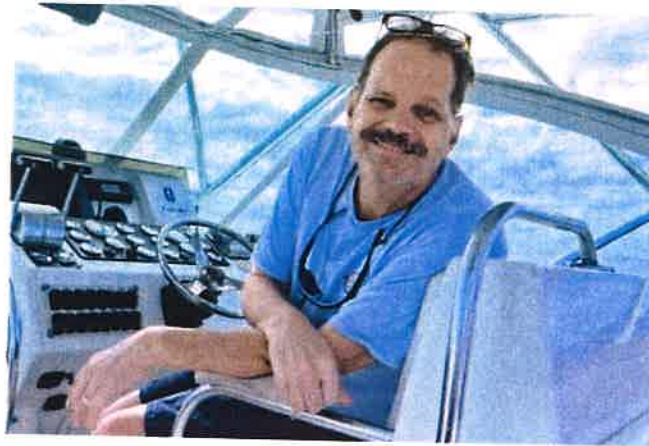

PUBLIC WORKS

Water Meter Readings

Thank you to everyone for your assistance with giving us a physical meter reading. The City will continue to read meters electronically. Your physical readings help with verifying your meters are reading accurately. As always, please reach out to City Hall with any questions.



§ 93.03 LICENSE APPLICATION: Written application shall be made in writing at the office of the City Clerk/Treasurer. The application shall state the name and address of the owner of the dog, the name, breed, age, sex, and color of the dog, and be accompanied by a certificate of vaccination from a qualified source certifying that the dog has been vaccinated against rabies, or has received a booster shot therefore, with the 24 month period immediately preceding the application.

§ 93.04 LICENSE FEE: Jan 1-March 31 the annual fee shall be \$5.00. April 1-Dec 31 the annual fee shall be \$25.00. Life Time fee is \$30.00

§ 93.08 RUNNING AT LARGE PROHIBITED: It shall be unlawful for the dog or cat of any person who owns, harbors, or keeps a dog or cat, to run at large. A person, who owns, harbors, or keeps a dog or cat which runs at large shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Dogs or cats on a leash and accompanied by a responsible person or accompanied by and under the control and direction of a responsible person, so as to be effectively restrained by command as by leash, shall be permitted in streets or on public land unless the city has posted an area with signs reading "Dogs or Cats Prohibited."

REMINDER: It is *your responsibility* to pick up after your pet. Lets all work together to keep our city looking beautiful!



§ 93.15 KEEPING OF CHICKENS:

ORDINANCE #2016-12-6A

- No more than 5 chickens are allowed on a premise. This permit does not include the keeping of a rooster. Roosters are NOT allowed on site.
- This Permit is good for one year and will expire on December 31 of each year. An Application fee of \$25 must be paid with this application and a renewal fee is due January 1.
- Chickens must be confined at all times in a chicken coop or chicken run. Chickens are not allowed to roam freely.
- The premise where the chickens are kept must be maintained in a healthy and sanitary condition and in a manner to prevent noxious or offensive odors being carried to adjacent property.

§74.03 ATVs, UTV & MINITRUCKS.

Every person that operates a special vehicle on designated roadways shall first obtain a permit from the City clerk.
